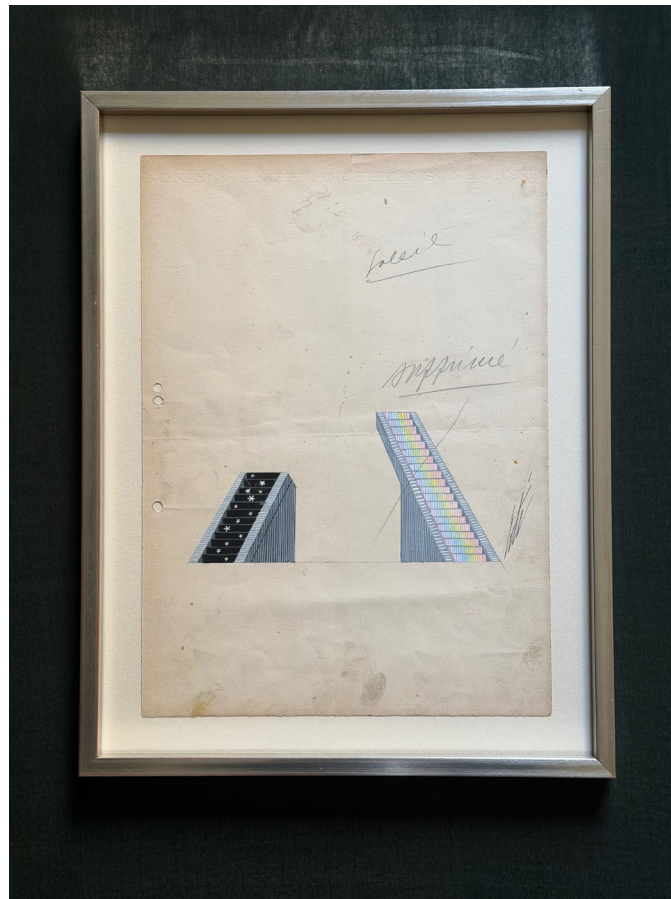




ERTE - STAIRCASE OF THE SUN
