



STERLING SILVER SUGAR CASTER



Urn-shaped silver sugar caster with domed pierced cover topped by a fluted knop finial. The body features vertical slotted piercings over a removable deep cobalt blue glass liner, flanked by applied lion mask ornaments. Decorative gadrooned and laurel leaf bands accent the rim and foot.

Small official hallmarks to the cover and body. Minor surface wear and light tarnish to silver, cobalt glass liner intact with no visible chips or cracks. Piercings and details show slight irregularities consistent with hand craftsmanship.
